AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TIME LIMITATION ON PARKING
RECREATIONAL MOTOR VEHICLES

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Twin Oaks, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. TITLE III, Chapter 365, of the Municipal Code is hereby amended to add new Sections 365.080 and 365.090 providing for RV Parking and Penalties, to read as follows:

Sec. 365.080: Parking of Recreational Vehicles.

No person shall park a recreational vehicle, including a boat, trailer or camper on any roadway for a period of time longer than 72 hours except in an emergency as determined by the Village Code Enforcement Officer or Their Designee.

Sec. 365.090: Penalty for violation.

Any person, firm or corporation found guilty of violation of this chapter shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or imprisoned for not more than ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be printed in the Code of Twin Oaks.

Section 3. This ordinance shall not take precedence over snow plowing and salting regulations contained in Schedule II-A of this TITLE; otherwise, all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. TITLE III, Schedule II-D is hereby amended by inclusion of the provisions of SECTION 365.080 as a final paragraph.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
