AN ORDINANCE APPROVING EMPLOYMENT OF A CORPORATE CONSULTANT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PREPARING AN ENHANCEMENT FUNDING APPLICATION FOR SUBMISSION TO THE EAST-WEST GATEWAY COORDINATING COUNCIL:

WHEREAS, the Village of Twin Oaks wishes to apply to the East-West Gateway Coordinating Council of Governments for the program years of 2010-2013 Transportation Improvement Surface Transportation Program-Suballocated Funds STP-S; and

WHEREAS, a proposal by Weis Design Group, dated January 8, 2009 for consulting services and preparation of a grant application under the East-West Gateway Coordinating Council's Enhancement Funds Program is approved as per Exhibit A attached to and incorporated in this Ordinance by reference; and

WHEREAS, Big Bend and Meramec Station Road are minor arterials and as such, may be eligible for said funding under this program. The proposed improvements shall be new crosswalks with colored and imprinted concrete to emphasize pedestrian and bicyclists movements, pedestrian signal countdown timers shall be installed, a new sidewalk shall be constructed along the west side of Meramec Station Road, curb ramps shall be upgraded within the project area, pedestrian scale landscaping, street lighting and beautification improvements shall be constructed throughout the project, helping with traffic calming and screening of the chain-link fencing, retaining walls, overhead power lines and other visual pollution that is common in vehicle focused corridors; and

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Twin Oaks, St. Louis County, State of Missouri, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Chairman and Village Administrator/Clerk are authorized to execute and approve such proposal or purchase order as necessary to promptly employ the services of the vendor herein selected.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance will not be printed in the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as by law provided.
