AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE IV., SECTION 410.110 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE (SIGNAGE DESIGN AND ILLUMINATION) BY PROHIBITING THE ILLUMINATION OF CERTAIN SIGNS DURING THE HOURS THAT A BUSINESS IS CLOSED:

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Twin Oaks, Missouri as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 410.110 of TITLE IV. is hereby amended by adoption of the following provision as Paragraph C:

C. All illuminated signs in all commercial districts for an individual business that advertise or promote goods or services shall be turned off during the hours that a business is closed. Emergency exit signs, security lighting and the principal business identification sign, may remain lit as needed or desired.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be printed in the Municipal Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
