AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VI, ARTICLE II, SECTION 605.030 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE (PREREQUISITES TO COMMERCIAL LICENSING):

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Twin Oaks, St. Louis County, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1: That SECTION 605.030 (TITLE 6, ARTICLE II) of the Municipal Code is repealed in favor of a new SECTION to read as follows:

SECTION 605.030: LICENSE PREREQUISITE

No license shall be issued to any merchant, business or occupation until all financial obligations, including personal property taxes, other license fees, permit fees or inspection fees, required to have been paid by such merchant, business or occupation to the Village have been paid. Additionally, no license shall be issued to any merchant, business or occupation until the State of Missouri has confirmed that a retail sales license (if required) has been obtained by the merchant, business or occupation and that no tax is due pursuant to the provisions of Section 144.083 RSMo.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as by law provided.
